Maryland Cancer Collaborative Organization Member Agreement Form

The goal of the *Maryland Cancer Collaborative* is to work with individuals and organizations throughout the state to implement the Maryland Comprehensive Cancer Control Plan. In addition, the Collaborative will bring together existing groups and new partners from across the state to collaborate on a common goal: reducing the burden of cancer in Maryland.

STRUCTURE

Steering Committee

- Comprised of the Chairs of each committee
- Facilitate communication within the Collaborative and with the community

Working Workgroup

- Six working workgroups: Access to Care and Services Workgroup, Communications Workgroup, HPV Vaccination Workgroup, Hospice Utilization Data Workgroup, and Tobacco Cessation Workgroup
- Each workgroup has a chair and co-chair
- Each workgroup reviews relevant chapters in the Cancer Plan and determines priorities to work toward
- Workgroups create and carry out action plans for their selected priorities

TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP FOR ORGANIZATIONS

- Collaboration and networking throughout the state to increase impact and maximize resources
- Regular updates on cancer control activities throughout Maryland
- Access to educational resources and training opportunities
- Opportunity to shape Maryland Cancer Collaborative activities

- Implementation of Cancer Plan strategies could potentially be conveyed as hospital community benefit services (depending on the specific activity) when reporting to the HSCRC.

 - Act on behalf of the organization

- Abide by and adhere to *Policy Ground Rules*
