Dear Governor Hogan and Chairs:

In accordance with the requirements set forth in Health – General Article §§ 13-1002(g) and 13-1102(h), the Maryland Department of Health submits the enclosed Final Fiscal Report for fiscal year 2017 and Interim Report for the first six months of fiscal year 2018 through December 31, 2017.

Funds available in fiscal year 2017 were \$25.1 million for the cancer program, \$9.7 million for the tobacco program, and \$13.2 million for the Breast and Cervical Cancer Diagnosis and Treatment Program. There was \$2,616,383 unspent in fiscal year 2017. The unspent funds revert to the Cigarette Restitution Fund in accordance with Health – General Article §\$13-1002(f)(1) and Section 13-1102(g)(1).

In fiscal year 2018, the legislative appropriation is \$25.1 million for the cancer program, \$9.7 million for the tobacco program, and \$13.2 million for the Breast and Cervical Cancer Diagnosis and Treatment Program. The combined unobligated fund balance for the cancer, tobacco, and Breast and Cervical Cancer programs is \$292,153 after six months of operations.


